

Dear Pescador,

Welcome to your fourth day and welcome to the Long Island Tres Dias community. You have, I hope experienced in some measure God's love for you during these past three days. As your fourth day lengthens you will have the opportunity to reflect upon the weekend itself and your place in it. A part of this reflection is your contemplation on how you are using your fourth day to grow in the love of Christ. Another part may be your interest to share this love with others by sponsoring them for a future Tres Dias weekend. And it is to this subject that this letter is addressed.

Our suggestion is that you might be led to invite family members, friends, co-workers, neighbors, and fellow church members. We would encourage you to invite people who are like yourself; interested in strengthening their walk with the Lord. Keep in mind that that the Tres Dias experience is not for everyone and an invitation to go on a weekend should not be used to resolve alcohol or drug issues or to heal people with deep emotional problems or serious relationships issues. The team members are not professionals and are not trained to handle such situations. The purpose of Tres Dias is to present talks and experiences which will help strengthen a person's relationship with God.

Your questions about sponsoring someone may include: how much do I tell a prospective candidate and do I have to keep anything a secret? The answer is to tell them about how you felt and how God touched you on the weekend. Sharing details about everything, may lead the person you are asking to anticipate events on the weekend rather than fully participating in them. The bottom line is that nothing is a secret and you are free to tell as much as you feel led. Keep in mind that describing specifics of the weekend may be difficult for the person who is not experiencing the weekend in full.

I hope that the experience of your weekend has had a positive effect on you and your walk and my hope is that you will want to have others in your life experience the same positive experiences too. I pray that are blessed in your fourth day and I pray that you know how much God loves you! I look forward to seeing you at the next Secuela.
