When & where?

October 25-27, 2019, at the **Quinipet Camp & Retreat Center, Shelter Island Heights, NY**. We will be taking a ferry across to Shelter Island. Ferry information can be found at www.northferry.com (Greenport), or www.southferry.com (North Haven). *Carpooling is strongly encouraged.*

What to expect?

The retreat will begin at 6 on Friday evening. Attendees may sign in upon arrival. There will be a short time of introduction. Please have dinner before you arrive, as there will be no meal provided that night. The accommodations are upper and lower bunk beds, mattress only, in a large dormitory room. Beds are limited; lower bunks will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis. Bring sheets, a blanket or sleeping bag, your own pillow, towel, toiletries, and flip flops for the shower. Shower and bathroom facilities are also shared dormitory style. Make sure you have a jacket or sweater, too, as the evenings may become chilly.

Saturday will have four Bible study sessions. Notebooks and pens will be provided, but please bring your own Bible. There will be prayer stations, times for meditation, and plenty of free time for rest and fellowship. The retreat will conclude on Sunday after lunch.

What is the cost?

The cost of the retreat is \$195, plus the cost of the ferry. Payment in full must accompany your registration. You can pay by check or money order. The \$195 includes accommodations, meals, & materials provided during the retreat.

What else should I know?

- Quinipet is not a smoke-free facility. Smoking is permitted outside in designated areas.
- The menu is predetermined. Those with questions can call Rory Schoenfeld for more info.
- Anyone 18 yrs. and older, who is seeking a relationship with God, is welcome to attend. Women and men will be housed in separate buildings, but all retreat activities will be co-ed.
- A sign-up sheet is being prepared to coordinate snacks and sundries that we will need; we will call you for your preferences.
